ABOUT THE LEAGUE

Northside Baseball & Softball was started in 2010 as a Christian sports ministry. Our goal is to provide a faith based approach to athletics and competition. We aim to provide healthy instruction, affirmation, and assistance to parents in giving their children meaningful activity as well as understanding about Jesus Christ. Practices are one night a week, either Monday, Tuesday, or Thursday. Games are on Saturdays at the Northside Fields.

Wee-ball

A co-ed league for 3 and 4 year old **boys and girls**. The emphasis will be on the basics of the game. All players will play at all times and all players will bat twice each game. The age cut off date is June 1st.

4-5-yr (Co-ed) 6-7 yr Coach Pitch Baseball

Players receive 5 pitches. Players get a swing from the Tee in the 4-5 year old league (no tee used in 6-7 yr old). A five run limit per inning is in place to ensure equal playing time for both hitting and fielding for both teams. Skill development and understanding of the game is emphasized.

6-8 yr Old Girls Coach Pitch

This league is for girls only. Players receive 5 pitches. A five run limit per inning is in place to ensure equal playing time for both hitting and fielding for both teams. Skill development and understanding of the game is emphasized.

8-9 Boys/8-10 Girls Machine Pitch

Players get 5 pitches from a machine. A real baseball/softball is introduced in this league. Skill development, individual position play, and understanding of the game is emphasized. Girls and boys play separately.

Challenger League - K-12th grade

This division is for children with disabilities. Practices and games are on Friday nights. Game play is light and customized to include all participants at the level they can participate.

There is no cost to participate.

All participants will receive a replica hat and jersey. Pants, socks and belt are not provided. Each player is required to provide his/her own glove and helmet in leagues it applies.

All skill levels are encouraged to get involved.
